Regular presentations about ongoing projects

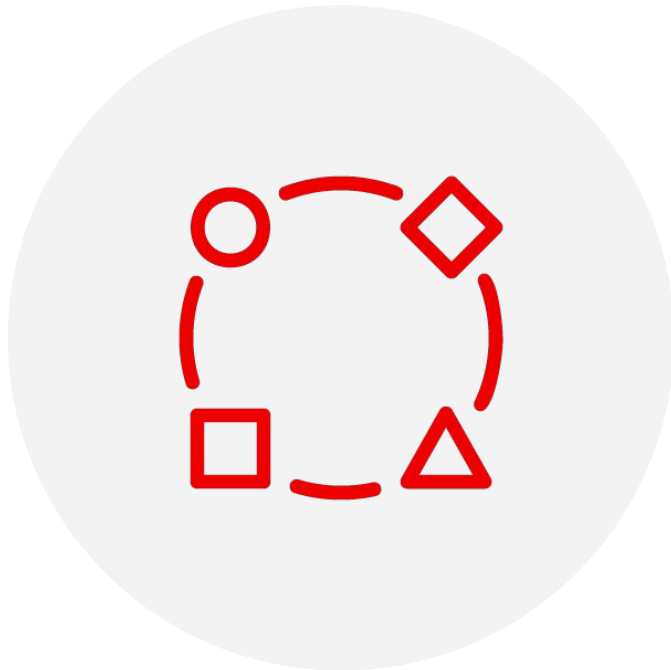
Discuss opportunities and make proposals
